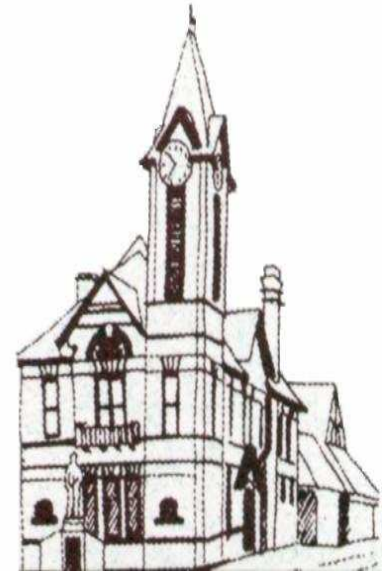

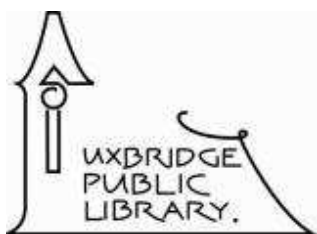

E-BOOKS @ THE LIBRARY

**To access and download E-Books and Audio books,
follow these steps:**

1. Go to our website, <http://uxlib.com>
2. Click on "downloadable audio books" (at the right)
3. Click "exit" at the bottom right corner of the screen that pops up.
4. Click on Login (at the top) and follow the instructions to login. Use the number on your library card and the password you set up at the library
5. At the left, click on whatever genre of E-Book or Audio book you want to download.
6. If the book you want is available, the words "add to cart" will appear. Click this and then "proceed to checkout" to download your digital book.
